

ALLERGIES

What is an allergy? It is an overreaction of your immune system to a substance that is normally harmless.

What is an allergen? It is a substance that triggers an allergy

Fact: 1:2 individuals suffer from an allergy requiring an OTC and/or Rx drug and/or injections on a weekly or monthly basis.

2/3rds of the population are affected by some kind of allergy/allergies.

How are allergies diagnosed?

1. Blood work: this looks at the levels and types of antibodies (AB) in the system. Once the AB is identified, the patient is injected with a solution of that AB (offending substance). This can potentially cause an acute allergic reaction then and there which may cause the patient to need immediate treatment in the ER.
2. Scratch/Prick Test: This involves needles which are used to inject suspected allergen substances. This is a very invasive test which requires the patient to be subjected to several pricks. By process of elimination, prick after prick, the patient will be most likely allergic to more than one substance. Once identified, the patient is then injected with the substance they are allergic to. Again, this too can lead to an acute allergic reaction with a need for immediate treatment in the ER.

How are allergies treated?

1. Avoidance once the substance/thing has been identified by trial and error. Usually by keeping a food diary or elimination diet under the supervision of a qualified dietician. This method usually fails as it requires strict supervision and avoidance of the things patients can normally not stay away from due to deep cravings or exposure to the substance they are allergic to reentering it into the body. If the allergy is environmental it will be rather hard in some circumstances to stay away from (i.e., pollen, ragweed, dust mites, air!) If the allergy is an animal it too can be hard to avoid in many instances. Many just medicate in order to be able to have animals or be in an environment where animals are.
2. Drugs over the counter or Rx drugs. Many have adverse side effects outside of what they do to your stomach, liver and kidneys (Claritin, Allegra, Singulair, Zyrtec, Musinex, Nasonex).
3. Inhalers- (Symbicort, Advair, Atrovent, Nebulizers, Albuteral, Flovent, Ventolin)

NOTE: All methods above treat the symptoms, NOT the cause of the problem!

It is a known fact that allergy treatments are only temporarily effective and only offer some relief of the symptoms still leaving the patient with some symptoms and some level of discomfort.

Allergy treatments also require repeated dosages whether it is medication, injections, creams or liquids. Literature shows these treatments are of limited effectiveness with demonstrated effective rates of 50% or less!

SO WHAT IS THE SOURCE OF THE PROBLEM? IT IS YOUR IMMUNE SYSTEM!

Your immune system: What are immunoglobulins (Ig)

Ig's are also known as your antibodies (AB). AB's are made by the immune system in response to bacteria, viruses, fungus, animal dander, and cancer cells. AB attach to foreign substances so the immune system can destroy them. AB made against your own tissues is called an autoimmune response. There are 5 major types of AB. We are most concerned with IgG and IgE when it comes to allergies.

IgG AB

Are found in all body fluids and are the most common AB. They fight bacterial and viral infections. IgG allergies are the most common and produce a Type III immune reaction. See symptoms below. Delayed responses are not uncommon and can occur hours to days after consuming an allergies substance. IgG type reactions can produce over 100 different symptoms and over 150 different medical diseases! 60-80 million Americans suffer from this type of allergy reaction. Symptoms include: Abdominal pain, general aches and pain, acne, ADHD, anxiety, arthritis, asthma, autism, bloating, celiac disease, chronic fatigue, chronic infections, constipation, depression, dizziness, eczema, enuresis (bed wetting), fibromyalgia, fluid retention, GI problems, hyperactivity, IBS (irritable bowel syndrome), itching, lethargy (tiredness), loss of appetite, migraines, nausea, PMS, psoriasis, recurrent ear and sinus infections, rhinitis, sinusitis, skin rashes, stomach cramps, tension, urticaria, weight gain or loss, and wheezing.

IgE AB

Are found in the lungs, skin and mucous membranes. They fight substances such as pollen, fungus, and animal dander. They may occur in allergic reactions to milk, some medicines and some poisons. In blood, IgE AB levels are high in people with allergies. IgE allergies are most common in children and genetically predisposed individuals. This Type I reaction causes a histamine reaction and result in immediate symptoms. Inflammation is the main symptom with this type of reaction. Stomach cramping, diarrhea, wheezing, asthma, skin conditions, stuffy, runny nose, and post nasal drip, rhinitis, and the most dreaded anaphylaxis. These are all examples of an IgE allergy.

Your immune system is your friend! Is designed to protect you by fighting off the bad guys! Your immune system produces good AB know as IgG and IgE in small amounts in order to fight off bacteria, viruses, parasites, molds, yeasts etc...

Now if you remember a substance that causes allergies is called an allergen. An allergen then causes the actual problem(s) in the Nervous System triggering the body to produce an over abundance of IgG and/or IgE triggering the allergic response. 95% of the time IgG is the culprit. This can be found in blood tests.

Most common Allergies:

1. Food
2. Environmental
3. Animals
4. Metals
5. Perfumes/Colognes
6. Dyes
8. Anaphylactic
9. Genetic/Inherited Predisposition

So then, abnormal immune responses (allergies) are of a:

Physical, Chemical or Emotional origin. All affect the Nervous System as a symptom of one sort or another. It is not uncommon that an allergy be brought on by a physical trauma or emotional (injury, divorce, abuse, failure, unhappiness, stress, fatigue, death). The body now recognizes the "food" or "thing" as bad or a threat to our system and produces a symptom of one sort or another= allergy.

Most common recognized allergy symptoms:

Sneezing, runny nose, hives, eczema, itching, rashes, eye irritation, post nasal drip, sinus congestion.

Less common symptoms:

Fatigue, abdominal pain/cramping, reoccurring sinus infections, nausea, diarrhea, constipation, chronic/reoccurring ear infections, gas, heartburn, joint or bone pain, and general swelling or stiffness.

You may be the victim of an undiagnosed allergy and are needlessly suffering for NO reason.

What is it and how does it work?

Bioallergenix along with affiliate partners have been improving their technology over the past 30 years. They have developed the BAX 3000 which can detect more than 35,000 substances associated with allergies, food sensitivities, and “other conditions”. The BAX is non-invasive and safe for ALL ages. It is a computer software system and Class 3 cold laser designed to detect and correct imbalances in the nervous/immune system. This in turn eliminates the allergy or “other condition” that the patient suffers from.

How is this possible?

The BAX works by testing, and detecting what the patient is allergic to. It may be one or variety of allergens. Once identified the patient is set up for laser treatments. The software program and laser devices expose the individual to a digitized antigen which matches the harmonic frequency of the actual allergen the patient has an allergy to. The body will react and the computer will note the response. The laser will then treat for the allergy by exposing the patient to the allergen by treating specific nerve bundles and acupuncture points on the body. If you have ever been treated for a severe allergic reaction involving anaphylaxis or needing an epinephrine shot to recover from the allergen that caused that specific allergy it is contraindicated for treatment.
